User Guide



Thank you for purchasing the Sharper Image Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone. Please read this guide and store it for future reference.

APPEARANCE AND STRUCTURE

1. Power On/Off switch
2. MIC hole
3. Pairing/MIC mute
4. Answer/End/Reject/Redial/Language choice
5. Decrease volume
6. USB port for software updates and charging
7. Built-in speaker
8. Steering wheel fixed bracket
9. Red/Blue indicator
10. Increase volume
11. Hands free/Cell phone switching

FEATURES

1. Easily mounts on any steering wheel
2. DSP technology, Full duplex, CVC noise and echo suppression
3. Support TTS function
4. Support MIC mute function
5. Answer/End/Reject a call, last call redialing and call switch
6. Support A2DP function [can play cell phone music]
7. Built-in microphone
8. Built-in Li-ion battery
9. USB port for software updates and charging
10. Connects automatically when power is on
11. Supports dual standby



INSTALLATION

Fix the device directly on the steering wheel.

1. Please attach the product to the bracket first.
2. Next, install the product bracket to the steering wheel.



OPERATION

When using your Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone for the first time, your cell phone must pair with it. Please refer to the user manual of your cell phone for specific details on Bluetooth connectivity.

- A. Power on and long press button for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode. While red and blue indicator lights flash, activate your cell phone's Bluetooth function, and search for the "CAR KIT" device on your phone.
- B. Select "CAR KIT" device.
- C. Enter the pass code "0000".
- D. Select "CAR KIT" from the list on the cell phone paired device, then select "connection."

Upon completion, a voice reminder will confirm that the first cell phone has successfully been paired. Only a blue light should flash now.

PAIRING THE SECOND PHONE

Press  button for 3 seconds to enter pairing mode. Red and blue lights flash in turn. Now, pair your second phone the same way you paired the first.

Note: *When connecting the second phone, the device will disconnect from the first cell phone automatically. After you succeed in connecting the second, please turn on the Bluetooth function of the first one again. There will be the prompt "Connect CAR KIT or not?" on it. Select "Connect," so that two cell phones are connected to the same Bluetooth hands-free device. Or, restart the device after the second cell phone is connected. Two cell phones can also be connected to the same Bluetooth hands-free device.*

FEATURES AND OPERATION

1. Power On/Off

When connected, dial a phone number directly on your cell phone. Your voice will automatically come through via Bluetooth hands free. The device will return to Standby mode after you hang up.

2. Hands-free talking

2.1 Receiving a call

When connected and you have an incoming call, the device will report who is calling via caller ID automatically. Press the  button to answer. You'll return to standby mode after hanging up.

2.2 Rejecting a call

Press the  button for 3 seconds to reject an incoming call.

2.3 Microphone mute

When using Bluetooth hands free and you don't want the other party to hear your voice, press the  button and the microphone will mute. Press the  button again and it will unmute, allowing your voice to once again be heard by the other party.

3. Phone call back

When connected, you can press the  button for 3 seconds to re-dial the last number you called.

4. Volume adjustment

While the power is on, short press the "+" and "-" buttons to adjust to your desired volume. A voice will prompt "Highest volume" and "Lowest volume."

5. Switching to hands free during a call

During a call, press the  button. You'll switch to hands free. Press the  button again to switch back.

6. Music mode

This device supports A2DP function. You can listen to music stored in your cell phone through the Bluetooth speaker.

6.1 When playing music:

Press the  button to Play/Pause

Press the "+" button to increase volume

Press the "-" button to decrease volume

6.2 When there is an incoming call, or when dialing, the device will automatically switch from music mode to phone call mode.

6.3 To exit music mode, just turn off the phone's music player.

6.4 Adjust volume accordingly when using the built-in speaker to play music.

7. Charging

The product has a built-in lithium-ion battery. When the battery is running low, please charge in time, otherwise it will power off automatically during use. When power is full, the indicator light changes from red to blue.



FEATURES AND OPERATION [CONT.]

7.1 Remove the device from the steering wheel bracket.

7.2 Plug the 5PIN Mini USB to USB charging port and insert the car charger into car cigarette lighter socket.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. If you are unable to connect your Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone to the cell phone, please check the following:
 - Ensure the Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone is switched ON
 - Ensure the Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone has enough battery power
 - Ensure the way your cell phone connects to the Steering Wheel Bluetooth Speakerphone is correct
 - Ensure the device is within a maximum of 30 feet of the mobile phone and there is no interference with other electronic equipment
2. Sound distortion
Adjust the volume accordingly to improve sound effects.
