5: Assembly Steps of Plate



*Press the detachable convex point of the vegetable basket with the index fingers of the left and right hands, and take out the vegetable basket.



*Press and hold the bumps on the side roof board and take out the front and rear roof. (if it is the roof board on the side of the mop, the mop shall be lowered first to pull out the buckle before taking out the roof board)



Align the buckles on both sides of the plate with the plastic on the side wall, and clip the two sides into the plastic until the snap point pops up. Then assemble the vegetable basket.



6: Brake Device / Use of Safety Belt / Retraction of Foot Pedal / Lowering of Side Wall / Vehicle Retraction

*Press the brake pipe with your foot to realize the braking state, and hook up the brake pipe to release the brake.



*When a baby sits in the car, be sure to fasten the safety belt to prevent the baby from jumping out of the car and falling and injuring.

The pedal is equipped with a zipper, which can be pulled up when the pedal is not required.



*Take out the roof board and the plate, and one side of the side wall can be untied for use as a seat (remember not to untie both sides of the wall at the same time).





wall closing button, both sides of the side wall are retracted inward, and both ends are retracted inward, so that the trailer can be closed, the mop button can be folded, and the buttons on both sides of the vegetable basket can be adjusted.



Maintenance

- 1. Disassembly. Before cleaning the stroller, first remove some cushions, seat covers, sunshades, baffles, etc. on the stroller.
- 2. Check. After disassembly, you can also check some gap positions of the stroller or whether there is any dirt on the wheels, such as rice or leaves, and clean them out.
- 3. Cleaning. All the items disassembled in the first step that can be cleaned by hand need to be cleaned manually. It should be noted that the water temperature should not be too high. It would be better to add some neutral detergent for cleaning.
- 4. Wipe. The entire metal frame of the stroller can be wiped directly with a clean wet cloth. No cleaning agent is required to avoid corroding the metal support.
- 5. Dry. After washing the items of the seat kit, you can dry them. After drying, it can be assembled. It is necessary to check whether the screws are loosened after assembly. It must be stable.

3: To Deploy a Trailer





Open the side wall and clip it into the plastic clips at both ends.



*Move the mop backward to make it parallel to the ground, and pull out the mop.

2: Schematic Diagram of Full Deployment of Trailer




Assembly Diagram of Front and Rear Wheels
